

VISITING THE DOG PARK?

Help keep your dog safe. If you see any of the following behaviors, you need to

**INTERVENE, INTERRUPT, &
PULL YOUR DOG OUT!**

RED ALERT BEHAVIORS:

1: ROLLING

When one dog makes physical contact with another and knocks into him, causing him to tumble, somersault or roll over.



2: TUCKED TAIL

When the dog's tail is so low the base is pressed tight to the anus. The tip of the tail is often under the stomach.



3: PINNING

When one or more dogs has another dog on its side or back for more than 5 seconds.



4: HIDING OR HOVERING

When the dog spends more than 5 seconds underneath something or hovering near a human. Dog's tail will be low or tucked.



5: GROUP CHASE

When more than one dog is chasing another dog. This can quickly become out of control.
